Rick called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Rick commented that it was January of 2001 when this Executive Order was created.

Rick reviewed the agenda items and asked if there were any questions regarding the agenda.

Lynn took the role.

Guy stated the closeout document was presented as a Powerpoint presentation at the November IMC meeting. At that time we advised the IMC we had 697 non-agencies on the program with a projected increase of 100 over the next two years. We have already jumped to 900 so the participation in MNT is well ahead of schedule! The Monday before the IMC presentation the Burlington ANAP was lit. This is about one month ahead of expectations. We now need to follow through on keeping track of the final 16 mile fiber build into Silverton to make sure Qwest finishes. As of now all 65 ANAPs are lit. MNT is now opening the way for Homeland Security, portal, voice over IP, video, etc. to grow. A motion was made at the IMC meeting to close the project and passed. It was suggested that DoIT report every August or September on the status of each year's metrics and the Silver fiber build. Additional copies of the closeout document have been given to the Governor's office. Rina stated that the group should be complimented. She has never
